# **PRESENTATION**

The Italian-Spanish International School of Proctology and Pelvic Floor Diseases is committed to enhancing the expertise required to establish a comprehensive clinical framework, interpret preoperative tests accurately, provide well-founded surgical indications, and ultimately elevate surgical standards. - Development of skills to recognize and manage complications.
- Ability to foster a multidisciplinary team approach for the development and management of shared protocols in the treatment of complex pelvic floor disorders.
